FIELD TRIP



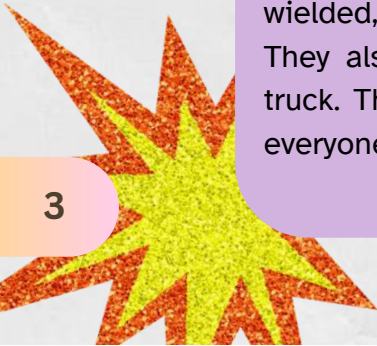

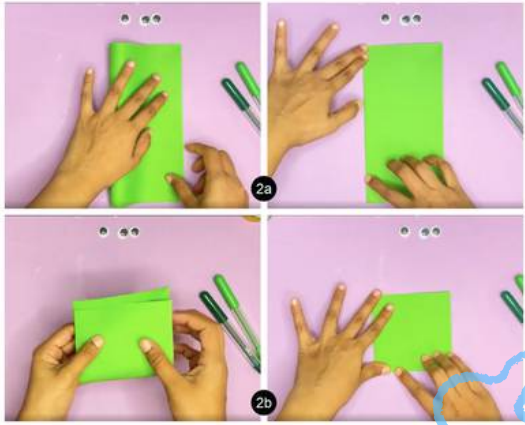
How to Make A Paper Frog

Are you bored of making the same thing over and over with your origami? Well if you are, here's how to make a cool paper frog to mix things up!

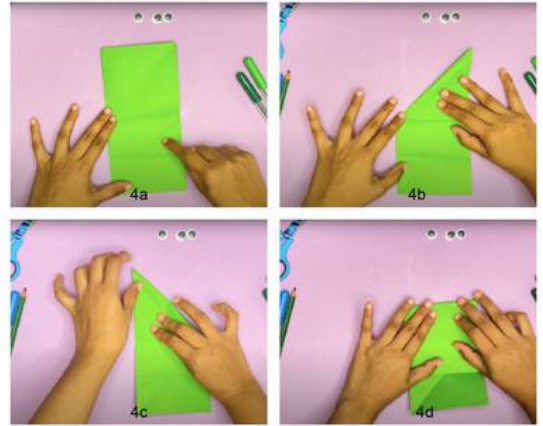
Step 1

Make the waterbomb base



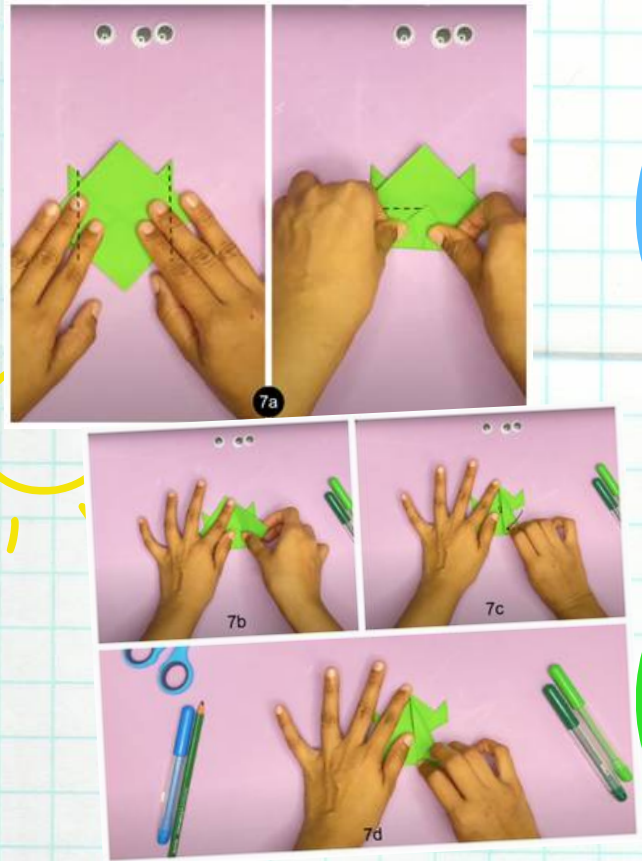

Fold the legs of the paper frog



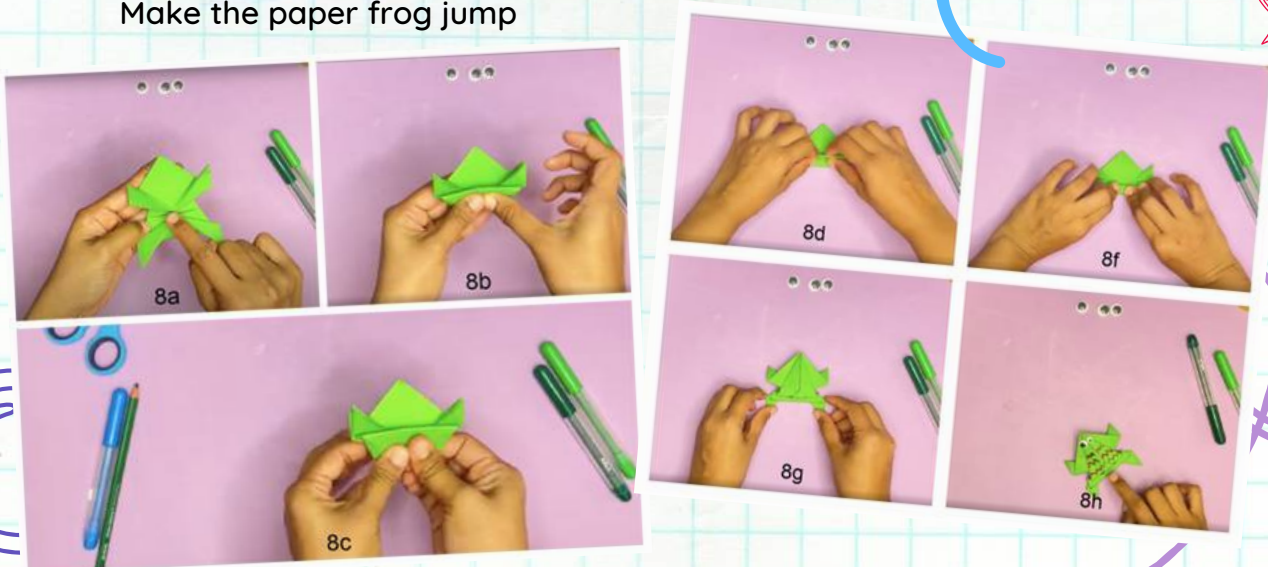

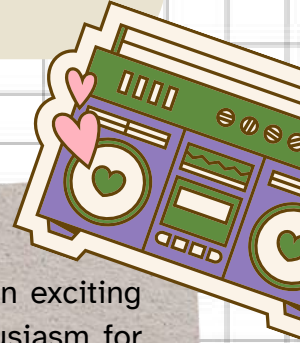
EXTRACURRICULAR

HIP HOP



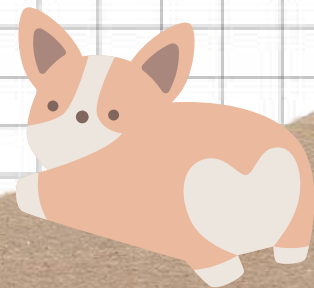

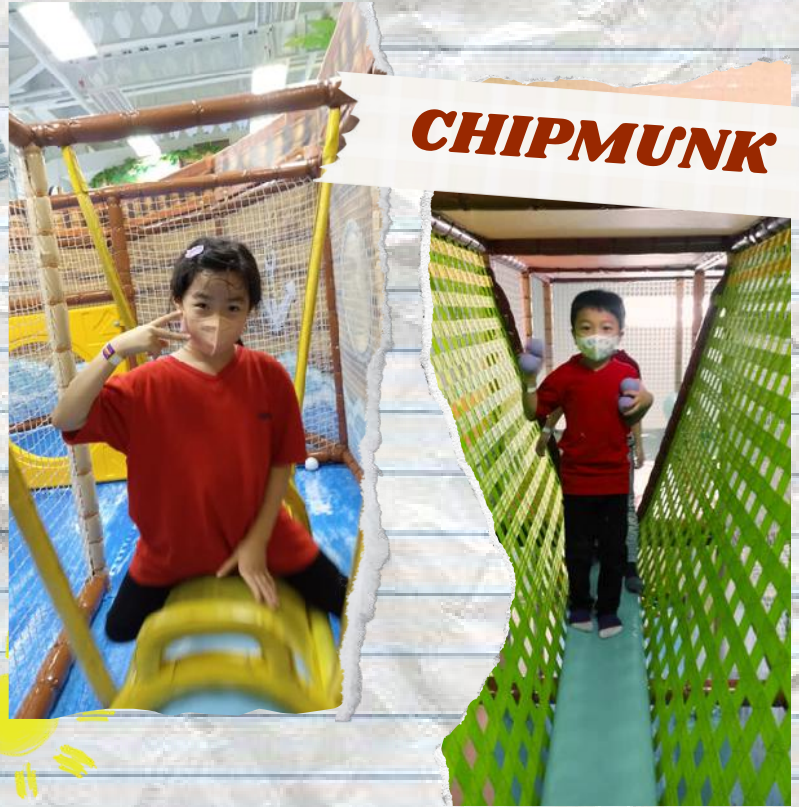
BASKETBALL

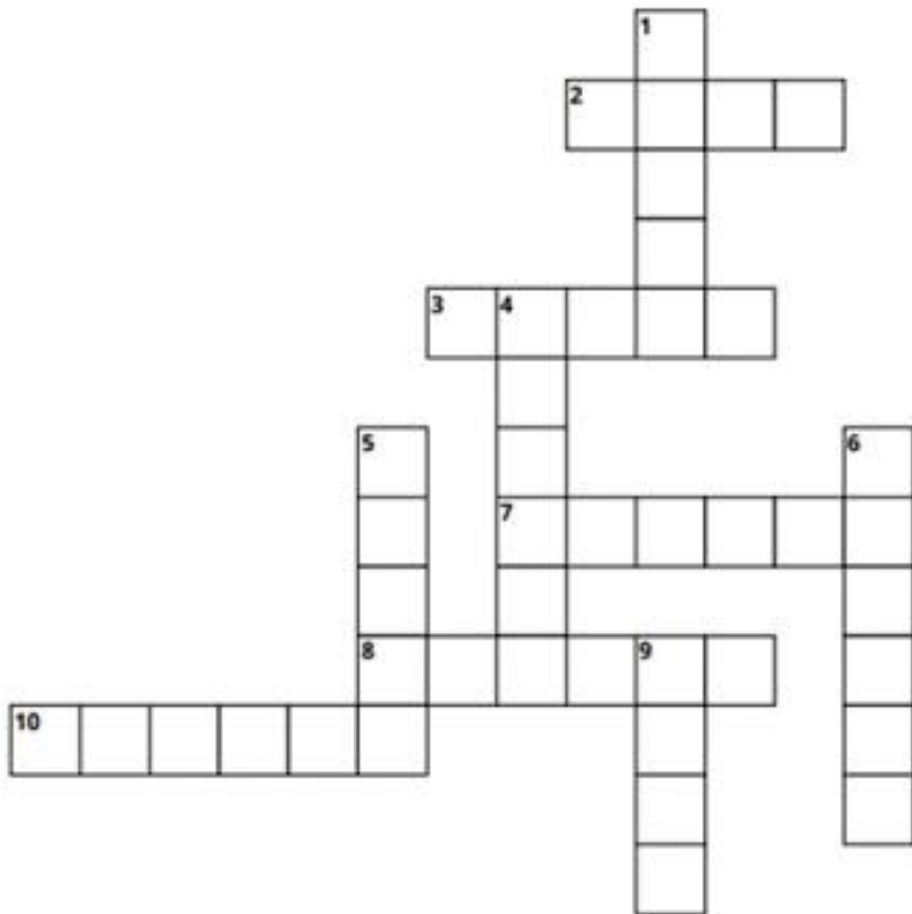
Reason #4: Develop Discipline

student council



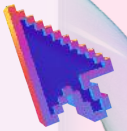

The Science Exhibition is a new event held specially this year to showcase 'Project Pancasila' which is a new project started by the government. As an addition, because Earth day is also celebrated in April, some of the projects are influenced by recycling waste and inventing new items to be used and bought by the public. The projects done by the students include, using paper pulp to create crafts, creating hydroponic plants, making a water filter, making homemade soap bars, creating new products using fermentation.



To start off, the students had to make proposals for their projects. Once it was approved, they could start creating their products and new inventions with the guidance of the Science and Art teachers. During the process, many experienced ups and downs due to mistakes in the proposals, not enough research and other mishaps. However, after a lot of perseverance, all the projects turned out to be outstanding and original to the groups. On the day, parents and elementary students came to observe the projects and ask questions about the products.

To celebrate national heroes day, Metta students visited Akademi Angkatan Laut, AAL in short, where students learned about how the Navy or Marine operates. Tackling Indonesia's Poor Health Problems:

challenges and opportunities

Indonesia, the world's fourth most populous country, is grappling with a multitude of health challenges. A significant portion of the population still faces poor health conditions and limited access to healthcare services.



High Disease Burden:

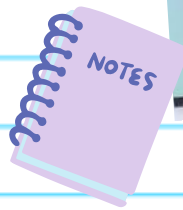

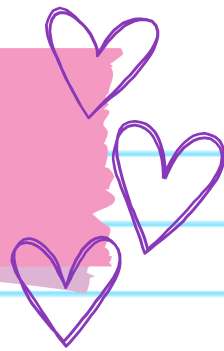

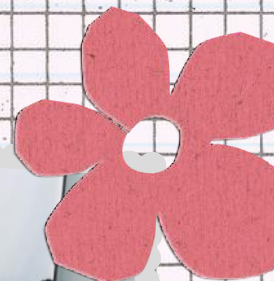
